

Demolition - Residential Permit Guidelines

*Does NOT apply to Pool Demolitions – see Pool Demolition Guideline.

Misc Demo's cover the demolition of any structure attached to the house. This may include a partial demolition within existing house per code violation, removal of a screen enclosure, removal of a wall inside the house, etc. If an existing home is being remodeled and has demo work within the scope of work, it would fall under a remodel permit.

CGC, CBC, CRC or Owner/Builder may apply for permit.

- Miscellaneous application.
- Two (2) copies of site plan scope of work to be done (if exterior portion of structure).
- Two (2) copies of floor plan showing interior area to be done.
- Owner Builder Affidavit (if homeowner).
- NOC required if value is \$2500 or greater.
